## Moving NMR infrastructures to remote access capabilities

October 2023

This is the second newsletter of the R-NMR project. R-NMR aims at organizing the strategies of NMR research infrastructures towards remote access. It is presently collecting information on the experience of facilities during the pandemic. R-NMR has been funded by the Horizon Europe programme since July 2022.

### *R-NMR Events and News*

On June 6, 2023, R-NMR hosted the first online workshop for remote access to NMR facilities. Videos of all the training materials have been compiled and are accessible on our website's [Training page](#). The first R-NMR consortium (annual) meeting was held at EUROMAR on July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023 in Glasgow, and included the presentations of the progress and achievements of WP2, WP3 and WP5. Discussion about Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) and CO<sub>2</sub> emissions took place as well. Also, a General Data Protection Requirement (GDPR) survey completed as part of Deliverable 2.1 (D2.1) and released on June 30<sup>th</sup>. Finally, the first R-NMR annual report (D5.4), along with the financial reporting of the R-NMR project, was accomplished and submitted to the EC portal, successfully.
